Nǐ hǎo ----- Hello! (among the friends)

Nín hǎo --- Hello! (show respect)

Shàng wǔ hǎo ----- Good morning!

Zǎo shang hǎo ----- Good morning!

Xià wǔ hǎo ----- Good afternoon!

Wǎn shang hǎo ----- Good evening!

Wǎn ān ----- Good night!



## *Useful Expressions*

Saying Goodbye:

Zài jiàn --- Goodbye!

Míng tiān jiàn --- See you tomorrow!

Duō bǎo zhòng --- Take care.

Thanks:

Xiè xie ---- Thank you!

Duō xiè ---- Thank you very much!

Bú yòng xiè ---- Not at all!

Bú kè qì ---- You're welcome!

### Apologies:

Duì bù qǐ---- I'm sorry!

Méi guān xi ---- It doesn't matter!

Duì bù qǐ , wǒ bù dǒng.

Sorry, I can't understand.

B: Wǒ hěn hǎo, nǐ ne?

- I'm fine, and you?

A: Bú cuò.

- Not bad.

- When there is an initial before “uei” , “uei” is written as “-ui”, such as “guì” and “duì”
- When used alone as syllables, “ ua,uo,uai” and “uei” are written as “wa, wo, wai”and “wei” respectively

### ■ Enquiring about nationality :

A: Nǐ shì nǎ guó rén?      What's your nationality?

B: Wǒ shì zhōng guó rén.      I am Chinese.
